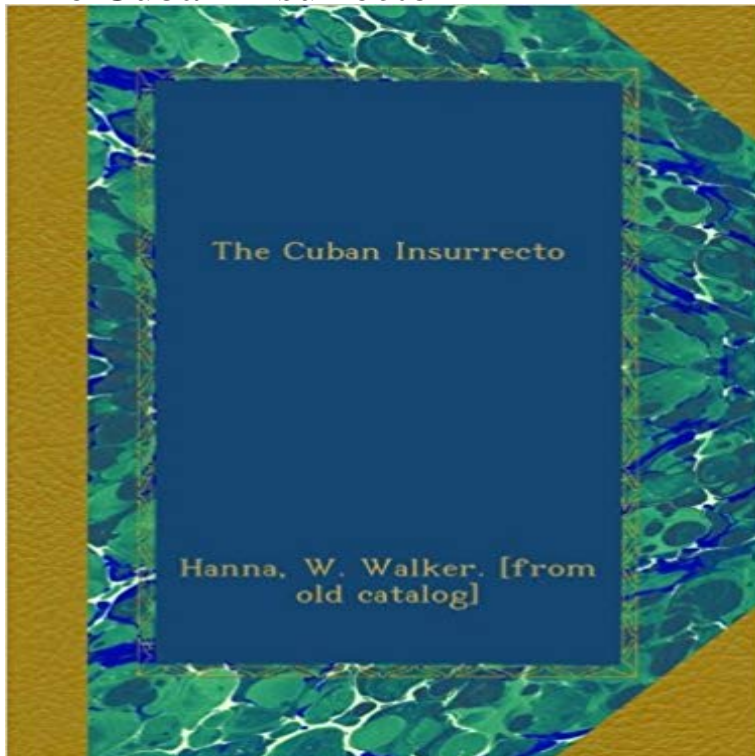


## The Cuban Insurrecto
