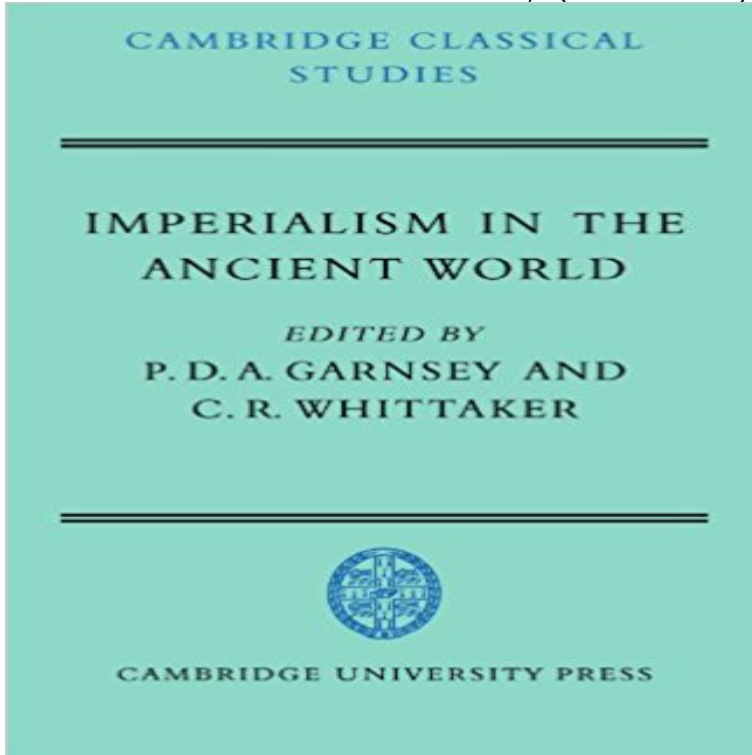


Imperialism in the Ancient World: The Cambridge University Research Seminar in Ancient History (Cambridge Classical Studies)
